# Feather & Fan Dress (Intermediate)

## MEASUREMENTS

### Months 3 (6-9-12)

Fits underarm 40

(45-47-50) cms/16 (18-19-20) ins

To measure (approx at underarm)

46 (52-54-58) cms/18 (21-21½-23) ins

Length (approx)

36 (40-43-45) cms/14 (16-17-18) ins

Sleeve Length

13 (16-18-19) cms/5 (6-7-7½) ins

## YARN

#018 or #019 1 x 300g ball

## NEEDLES

A pair each 4.00mm (US 6), (UK 8) and 3.25mm (US 3), (UK 10) Knitting Needles **or sizes that give correct tension/gauge.**

## MATERIALS

A Yarn Needle; 2 Stitch Holders.

## TENSION/GAUGE

**21 sts and 29 rows to 10 cms/4 ins over stocking st, using 4.00mm (US 6), (UK 8) Knitting Needles.**

**Note - Correct tension/gauge is essential for a successful handknit.**

## ABBREVIATIONS

**St/s** - stitch/es, **K** - Knit, **P** - Purl, **RS** - right side, **WS** - wrong side, **garter st** - every row knit, **stocking st** - 1 row K, 1 row P, **beg** - begin/ning, **patt** - pattern, **K2tog** - knit 2 sts together, **yfwd** - yarn forward to make a stitch, **incl** - inclusive, **rep** - repeat, **rem** - remain/ing, **cont** - continue, **dec** - decrease, **inc** - increase.

## CREATE

### Back and Front (both alike)

Using 3.25mm (US 3), (UK 10) Needles, cast on 74 (74-92-92) sts.

Knit 3 rows garter st (1st row is WS).

Change to 4.00mm (US 6), (UK 8) Needles.

**Beg patt - 1st row (RS) - Knit.**

**2nd row - Purl.**

**3rd row - K1, \* (K2tog) 3 times, (yfwd, K1) 6 times, (K2tog) 3 times, rep from \* to last st, K1.**

**4th row - Knit.**

Rows 1 to 4 incl form patt.

Cont in patt until work measures approx 25 (28-30-31) cms/10 (11-12-12½) ins from beg, ending with a 4th row.

**Next row - K3 (4-13-0), K2tog, \* K1 (2-0-1), K2tog, rep from \* to last 3 (4-13-0) sts, K3 (4-14-0) = 51 (57-59-61) sts.**

**Next row - Purl.**

**Shape armholes -** Cont in stocking st for rem and cast/bind off 3 sts at beg of next 2 rows = 45 (51-53-55) sts.

Dec one st at each end of next row, then in every foll alt row until 41 (47-49-51) sts rem.

Cont without shaping until **armhole** measures 6 (7-7-8) cms/2 (2½-2½-3) ins, ending with a purl row.

**Shape neck - Next row (RS) - K15 (17-18-19), turn.**

\*\*\* Cont on these 15 (17-18-19) sts.

Dec one st at neck edge in every row until 10 (12-12-12) sts rem.

Cont without shaping until **armhole** measures 11 (12-13-14) cms/4 (4½-5-5½) ins, ending with a purl row.

**Shape shoulder -** Cast/bind off 5 (6-6-6) sts at beg of next row. Work 1 row. Cast/bind off rem 5 (6-6-6) sts. \*\*\*

Slip next 11 (13-13-13) sts on a stitch holder and leave.

With RS facing, join yarn to rem sts and knit to end.

Rep from \*\*\* to \*\*\*, working 1 row more before shoulder shaping.

### Sleeve (make 2)

Using 3.25mm (US 3), (UK 10) Needles, cast on 29 (31-33-33) sts.

Knit 3 rows garter st (1st row is WS).

Change to 4.00mm (US 6), (UK 8) Needles.

Work 2 rows stocking st.

Cont in stocking st, inc one st at each end of next row, then in every foll 4th (**6th-6th-6th**) row until there are 37 (**39-43-45**) sts.

Cont without shaping until work measures 13 (**16-18-19**) cms/5 (**6-7-7½**) ins from beg, ending with a purl row.

**Shape top** - Cast/bind off 2 sts at beg of next 2 rows = 33 (**35-39-41**) sts.

Dec one st at each end of next row, then in every foll alt row until 13 (**13-17-17**) sts rem, then in every row until 7 sts rem. Cast/bind off.

### **Neckband**

Using yarn needle and mattress st seam, join right shoulder seam. With RS facing and using 3.25mm (US 3), (UK 10) Needles, knit up 10 (**10-12-12**) sts evenly along left front neck, knit across sts from front stitch holder, knit up 10 (**10-12-12**) sts evenly along right front neck, 10 (**10-12-12**) sts evenly along right back neck, knit across sts from back stitch holder, then knit up 10 (**10-12-12**) sts evenly along left back neck = 62 (**66-74-74**) sts.

Knit 3 rows garter st. Cast/bind off loosely knitways.

### **FINISHING**

DO NOT PRESS. Using yarn needle, darn in ends.

Using yarn needle and mattress st seam, join left shoulder and neckband seam. Join side and sleeve seams. Sew in sleeves.
